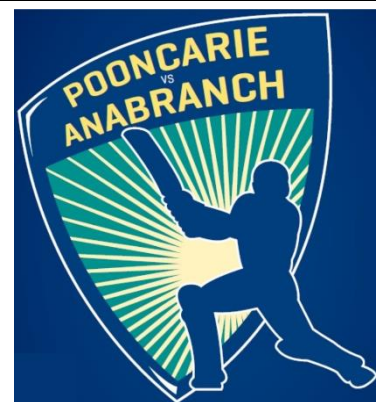
CRICKET MATCH ANABRANCH vs POONCARIÉ teams
